

2024 Pool Rules

General

The pool will operate on a Swim at Your Own Risk (SAYOR) basis. No life guard or monitors will be provided. Association Members have the responsibility to call attention to a violation or inherent dangerous behavior. Repeated violations can result in the revocation of pool privileges. The pool area will be under 24/7 video surveillance.

Entrance Requirements:

- Only individuals 18 years or older, who have completed a Liability Waiver, will be provided a pool
 gate entrance code. This code will not be shared with non-members, individuals younger than 18
 years, or Association residents who have not completed a Release of Liability and Waiver form.
- <u>Individuals less than 18 years old</u> must be listed on a parent's signed Liability Waiver and accompanied by a parent (or an older sibling, designated resident neighbor, nanny, or sitter in a parental role) who is 18 years or older.
- A member family may have up to 6 guests total in the pool area. A single guest family that has more than 6 members is acceptable. The sponsor must be present at all times.
- <u>Each individual 18 years or older will sign in upon entry</u> and record the accompanying total number of people entering.
- No pets are permitted in the pool or pavilion areas.
- The pool and pavilion are non-smoking areas.

Swimmers May Not:

- Enter the pool if under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or have a communicable skin, eye, or ear infection.
- Run in the pool area.
- Dive, twist, or flip into a pool from any side.
- Fight, rough house, or wrestle in the pool area.
- Push or throw another person into the pool.
- Hold another swimmer involuntarily under water.
- Use profane language or play loud music.
- Use a glass container in the pool area.
- Consume or possess alcohol in the pool area.
- Leave trash / waste, or fail to deposit such in a trash receptacle upon leaving.
- Disturb any security camera.
